STRIKE ACTION 1ST NOVEMBER 2023

Dear Parent/Carer

You will have received communication from Renfrewshire Council regarding strike action on Wednesday 1st November 2023. The school will be closed to ALL pupils and staff on this day.

Pupils will receive work through online platforms, primarily Microsoft Teams, although some departments may also use Satchel One (the online platform through which all homework is set for pupils). Each department will ensure pupils are clear on how to access their classwork before the strike day.

Pupils will only be allocated work from the classes they would have attended in school on Wednesday and wherever possible should follow the guidance below.

- Pupils should follow their normal Wednesday class schedule.
- Pupils should check they have access to the Teams page for each of their classes in advance of Wednesday and speak to their teacher if they have any issues.
- Pupils should spend no more than 50 minutes on each lesson. If a task is not completed, please do not worry, your child should move on to the next lesson.
- Pupils should take their morning break at 10.30am as usual and a 45-minute lunchbreak as normal.
- Encourage small movement breaks between each lesson.
- The school day ends at 2.50pm on a Wednesday. Encourage your child to stick to these working hours, and don't extend the day trying to complete tasks.

If you have any questions regarding your child's learning prior to the strike day, then please contact the school office before 3.40pm on Tuesday 31st October and they will direct your enquiry to the appropriate staff member.
