

## **March Assessments 2023**

## Notes for pupils:

- 1. As with all Renfrewshire schools, there is **NO STUDY LEAVE** for prelim exams. If an exam finishes during a period, pupils are permitted to wait quietly in the canteen until the next period bell before going to class. If a pupil has no exam in the morning then they are expected to attend class.
- 2. Please check the exam board outside the assembly hall carefully to find out where each exam is taking place as some exams will be in classrooms.
- 3. Any exam clashes should be reported to your class teacher to allow them to rearrange a time for you to complete this. Exams taking place in the hall should take priority.
- 4. You will need your Scottish Candidate Number for every exam. These should be written on the front of your exam paper. You will be allowed to take a note of this number in with you on an otherwise blank piece of paper.
- 5. Pupils should check their seat number which will be displayed outside the assembly hall before each exam. It is your responsibility to know your seat number.
- 6. Please ensure you are at the exam location **AT LEAST 10 minutes** before the start of each exam. The start time indicated is for when you are seated and ready to begin writing and not entering the location.
- 7. Pupils MUST wear school uniform for all exams.
- 8. If you feel unwell BEFORE an exam and you have not arrived at school you or your parent must telephone and speak with a member of the office staff. If you feel unwell BEFORE an exam and you have arrived in school you must speak with Mrs Davidson.
- 9. If you feel unwell DURING an exam you must inform an invigilator IMMEDIATELY.
- 10. During an exam you are not permitted to have a mobile phone, smart watch or any other electronic device. If the device is placed in a bag prior to the exam IT MUST BE SWITCHED OFF OR PUT ON SILENT.
- 11. You may only bring WATER into the exam location and bottles MUST be placed on the ground at your desk.
- 12. You must listen carefully to the instructions issued to you at the start on an exam and adhere to them.
- 13. Any talking or inappropriate behaviour during an exam will be dealt with very seriously and may result in reduction in marks or cancellation of your grade.
- 14. You may not enter or leave the exam location (hall or classroom) until you are told to do so. The invigilators will let you know when it is appropriate to do so.
- 15. If you have an early start exam, in the afternoon, please ensure you leave your previous class early to allow lunch to be eaten.
